If you are a UK tax-payer, you can declare that all donations made under your declaration should be treated as Gift Aid donations. Doing so maximises your gift: currently we can reclaim 25p for every £1 you donate, at no further cost to you. If you pay less Income Tax and/ or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all my donations in that tax year, it is your responsibility to pay any difference.

Your declaration covers donations that you may make in the future. Please notify the Cumberland Lodge Development Office if you change your name or address while the declaration remains in force, or cease to be a UK tax-payer. You may cancel the declaration by notifying the Development Office. The declaration will not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or specified later date. If you are unsure whether your donation qualifies for Gift Aid, we will be pleased to advise you. Please contact the Development Office at the address above.

- Once sponsored, the table or chair will remain the property of Cumberland Lodge.
- Sponsorship of a chair does not entitle the sponsor to any special admission or seating rights.
- While the furniture is expected to last for many years and every effort will be made to avoid damage, no guarantee can be given that any one chair or table will be in position for any specific period of time.
- Cumberland Lodge reserves the right to have the final say as to what may be inscribed on the plaque.
- The design of the chairs for Cumberland Lodge have not yet been finalised. The images used on this leaflet are representative of the look and feel of the finished chairs.
